President's Report

As everyone is aware, our business is on a firm planning, action and evaluation base and this year we introduced and met our second annual Business Plan. The plan has a vision -

"By 2003 the Belconnen Magpies Football Club will be the premier club in North Canberra, demonstrated by its professional management, financial success, a high community profile and a First Grade Premiership." We should all be very proud that we have reached this vision, ahead of time.

I am not too perturbed about us developing an exciting new vision. How is this for a first draft?

"By 2006 the Belconnen Magpies Football Club will be the premier club in the AFL Canberra competition, demonstrated by its professional management, financial success, high community profile and further premiership success across all grades."

If we all continue to work as hard, if not harder, than we did this year, there is no reason why we can't reach this vision also.

The Club has continued to make progress during the 2002 season. All six teams were very competitive and all made their respective finals series. The end result of one premiership team and two runners-up belies just how competitive we were, in all grades.

Congratulations to 1st Grade on being Premiers. It is difficult to comprehend that this fine Club has taken 32 years to win one, however, every club has to win a first one and sometimes it is quick and sometimes it is slow. There is only one word to describe their season and that is 'awesome'. I know there were a few doubters early in the season when we lost match-winners like Ben Aulich and David Coupe. However, some astute recruiting picked up extremely handy players like Steve Hazelman, Selesi Uhi, Brock Weston, Jon Alexander and Mick Sherry to add to an already strong squad.

The Match Committee, led by Darren Denneman, then added their magic to the mix to obtain significant improvement out of

a number of players, both experienced and inexperienced. The team was instilled with a magnificent teamwork ethic and willingness to sacrifice for each other. This came out ever so clearly in the finals when it proved equally impossible to pick out star players and/or non-contributors. This was as close to teamwork perfection as I have seen in 44 years of following the game. There is only one motto that comes to mind for next year and that it **"Back to back"**.

The Development Squad finished the season very strongly with excellent performances in the 1st Semi and Preliminary finals. They were unlucky to run out of fit players in the Grand Final and this cost them dearly. Still, they played some exciting team football and clearly produced many individual players who were capable of giving a good account of themselves in the highest grade, had they been needed.

The under 18s had a good year but could not reach top gear during their semi-final to finish 4th. The Thirds had a very good year but could not clear the final hurdle in the Grand Final against a fitter ADFA outfit. The women's team improved tremendously over the year and were pipped by two points in their Semi-final. Congratulations to Alice Broughton on her All-Australian selection. The fourths played some fantastic games throughout the year, including the 1st Semi. However, they were inconsistent and that eventually caught up with them.

Congratulations to Steve Maher on his media award win, Doug Reid on winning both the Reserves competition best & fairest trophy and media award and Marty Rice on winning the Under 18 competition best & fairest trophy. Congratulations to all the Club trophy winners.

Congratulations to Adam Garrett on reaching the 100 senior game milestone. Your form this year suggests that you have many more senior games in you, Carrots. Also, congratulations to Snake Campbell on All-Australian selection.

All of the Club directors have performed very

- ♦ Adam Garrett playing his 100th Senior game.

Football Committee Report

Premiership Year 2002

First of all congratulations to all club personnel who have made contributions over the past 32 years to make this our first senior premiership year. Thanks to your endeavours, persistence and ambition to make this club such a great club.

This year, the Football Committee included some new faces following Mick Danaher's decision to stand down after many years of heading up the committee.

The first game of the season saw the senior grades funning out in new design jumpers sponsored by Sayers Property Group. In addition, new style training jumpers with the IMB logo were worn by players.

Plans to return football to the heart of Belconnen are underway with the imminent signing of an agreement with Wests Rugby Union Club for an ongoing and permanent use of Jamison Oval.

It is planned that third and fourth grades will use Jamison for 2003 season with senior grades continuing to use Jamison oval on a limited basis, as it has been for the past seasons until change room facilities are improved, to meet Canberra AFL standards. Kippax oval will continue to be used as training headquarters.

During the year improvements were made to the Kippax training sheds, with the installation of security lighting (by Affinity Electrical) and roofing to the alleyway between the shed and pavilion (sponsored by WR Engineering) to provide additional equipment storage.

The Medical Support Staff were ably led by Gary Schmidt, our Head Trainer. This group of personnel are a vital cog, particularly on match days, at the club and

often perform long hours to ensure our players are as medically fit as possible. Through Gary's efforts over \$900 has been raised towards medical equipment through Sunday raffles at the club.

Special thanks to Kate Danaher and Paula Peralta who are unavailable next year. We hope to see you back some time in the future.

Catering was a financial success this year, thanks to the efforts of Scott Reid, Meg Day, Sarah Edwards and Yvonne Davies, with special mentions to Brian for undertaking the cooking and Kerry Fitzgerald for supplying yummy soups, particularly on those bitterly cold days. Many people also volunteered to help in the canteens and to those people, the Club says a BIG thank you.

Development Squad

Congratulations to Darren Denneman and his team on producing Belconnen Football Club's first ever First Grade premiership in 2002. Hopefully it will be the first on many to come. It is also pleasing that the club has made the commitment to extend Darren's coaching appointment, ensuring he will be at the helm for the foreseeable future. The professionalism, enthusiasm and expertise he has brought to the club are a big part of the recipe for the success this year and the solid foundation on which to build a club that will now see continued success on that last game in September.

I was extremely pleased, at the beginning of this season, that the club committed to utilising the Development Squad exactly as the name suggests, as a development squad for the club. We agreed that winning at this level was not the ultimate goal, that rather we would judge our success through the development of the players that had the potential to play first grade football at Belconnen. To this end it is exciting for the club's future that 14 players who were still eligible to play Under 18 football played in the Development Squad throughout the year. They were: Lexie Bennett, Hugh Gulliver, Rory Markham, Jeremy Brodie-Reed, Chris Hally-Burton, Josh Preston, Nick Costello, Billy Hitzartzidis, Matt Pryor, Tim Drage, Ben Langham, Martin Rice, Daniel Griffiths, David Love.

Of these players Lexie Bennett and Matt Pryor played the majority of games in the Development Squad with Lexie playing several games in First Grade. Lexie certainly showed in these games and particularly in the Development Squad finals games that he has the attributes to be a regular First Grade player in the future. I look forward to seeing all those players that will progress to senior football from the Under 18s playing with the club next year.

Throughout the season a number of players were selected from the Third Grade to play in the Development Squad. All these players acquitted themselves admirably and performed very well, ensuring the club's philosophy of players playing at their highest possible level worked pretty well this year. Chris Calvert and Chris McDevitt both made the transition from Third Grade last year to the Development Squad this year and were integral parts of the finals side. Chris Calvert had an outstanding

year and was our most improved player. If we can keep him fit for the full season he is very capable of even better football.

On and off the field this season the Development Squad effectively mirrored the First Grade in their preparation, pre-game routine, kick out routine, general style of play, positive game plan, and post game recovery. I believe this ensured the players who moved up a level were well prepared for the processes they confronted and helped each one positively contribute in the games they played. A particularly outstanding achievement was the form displayed by Sol Fitzgerald who moved to First Grade after playing the first five games in the Development Squad. He now has a premiership medallion for his efforts. With the club's aim that only players who are capable of First Grade football playing in the Development Squad, Sol's achievements should be an inspiration to these guys and shows what can be achieved with the required commitment.

Getting to the results on the field, I was happy with our efforts in the majority of the home and away games during the regular season but was extremely impressed with the guys throughout the finals series to make it to the Grand Final. At three quarter time in the Grand Final, being 5 points up, I truly thought we were a real chance. It was unfortunate that we received a couple of injuries to key players during the game and the toll of a hard finals campaign finally caught up to us. When I addressed the players after the game I was truly disappointed for them as I believe that every player put in their all for the club, but we were beaten by a better team on the day. It is a valuable learning experience that I hope spurs all these guys on to bigger and better things next season.

I can't go any further without congratulating Doug Reid for winning the ACTAFL Reserve Grade best and fairest award, the club's Development Squad best and fairest award as well as the T.W Sherrin Player of the Year award. For one of the smallest players in the club he certainly plays with a big heart and is a deserved recipient of these accolades. Congratulations also to Tony Maher who was the club runner-up best and fairest. Tony

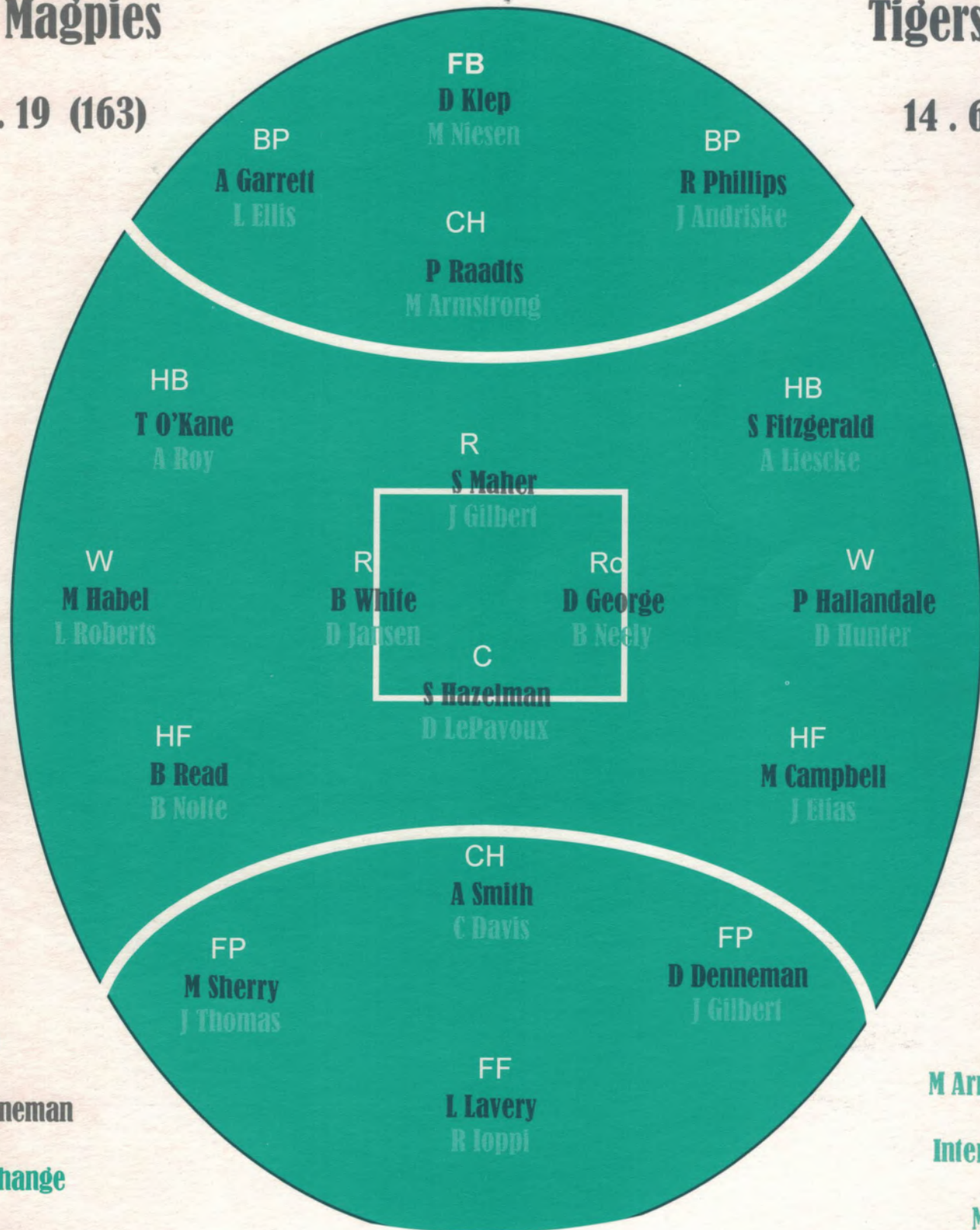
