Treasurer's Report



The 2016 budget was set to run at a \$11,000 loss (2015 \$31,000 loss). The year ended with an operating loss of \$17,071. Income for the year was under budget by \$34,199 or 10.7%, with expenditure being \$28,427 less than expected.

Revenue for 2016 was \$286,801 (10.6% under budget and 0.8% down on 2015.

Expenditure for 2016 was 303,873 (8.6% under budget and 1.1% up on 2015. Most categories of expenditure were under budget except for:

- AFL affiliation 9.6% over budget and 9.8% up on 2015.
- Coaching 8.4% over budget and 6.1% down on 2015.
- Medical staff & supplies 2.4% over budget and 17.9% up on 2015.

The challenge for 2017 will be to involve more

volunteers and to meet fundraising targets in all categories.

The Club is fortunate to have many dedicated volunteers who give their time across all areas of the Club. Thank you to the Committee for your contribution and guidance. To Scott Reid, Jo Foster and Terri Jamieson, thank you for your support.

Thanks to Len Haddrill (Senior Football Coordinator) for his work during the year and the support he has given me as Treasurer.

Thanks to Katrina Gallway and Len Haddrill for your efforts organising and running functions. It's great to see a number of players helping in this area.

Rob Lamb came onto the Board to oversee volunteers and did a great job under difficult circumstances, thanks Rob. Any volunteers keen to help out the Club, please contact Rob to get involved.

Each of you has contributed an amazing amount of time in a variety of roles and it has been a pleasure working with you all. A special thank you must go to the BMFC exec for the countless hours you all put in to help the football club be successful in one way or another. Thank you for all your help and support throughout this journey thus far, and I personally look forward to continuing to work with all of you next year.

The 2016 season was an interesting year. It was the first time in many years that the Football Club had only 5 teams play the duration of the season. Unfortunately due to lack of numbers and depth the Football Club had to pull our third grade side after only a couple of rounds of the 2016 season. As hard of a decision as this was for the board to make, I believe it was the correct decision as the numbers were just not there to field two district teams.

There was a mixture of success and disappointment throughout all five BMFC teams throughout the 2016 football season. First grade lost a preliminary final to Queanbeyan by two points. The side was down by 30 points at half time and showed plenty of heart in the second half which portrays positive signs for the 2017 season. Almost all players from the 2016 senior squad have recommitted to play on in the 2017 season, which is great to see. New recruit Beau Walker settled in quickly and soon become an integral part of the BMFC midfield alongside Mulrooney medallist James Bennett and captain Lexie Bennett. The Midfield proved to be one of the side's strongest assets and it is great to see all members of the elite midfield recommitted for 2017.

To see the amount of young talent running around

was very pleasing and again showed positive signs for years to come. The likes of Joseph Kenna who is only 17 years of ages playing a key position for the first grade side shows promise and potential for the Football Club. Other young talent such as Adam Lamb, Sam O'Sullivan and Paddy Horan showed great progress throughout the year and with another preseason under their belt will be players to watch in 2017.

Reserve grade played Ainslie in the 2016 Grand Final at Manuka and unfortunately went down by 19 points. Ainslie two weeks earlier beat Belconnen by over 100 points so again some positives can be taken out of the Grand final loss and used to go one step further next year. Rising Stars struggled for numbers all year with under 17's backing up and playing two games most weekends. I would like to give a big special thankyou to both Jason Kidney and Brendan Trevaskis on their efforts in fielding a side week in week out. The Women's side made the preliminary final this year with a very new and raw group of girls. A total of 10 girls who played for the women's side this year had never played Australian Rules football before this season. The development and progress of the entire side throughout the 2016 season was outstanding and sets a great platform for success next year and beyond. A huge thank you must once again go to Scott Reid for stepping in and filling the position of head coach. Scott coached 3 teams this season including two youth girls' sides and the senior women's side and must be applauded for his efforts.

As stated before there was only one district football side this year due to lack of numbers and depth. Fourth grade narrowly missed finals this season and improved dramatically when forced to drop a side. Hopefully the relationship with University of Canberra and BMFC can continue to improve and we as a club can recruit more players through this relationship as it grows stronger.

A special mention must go to Jeremy Rowe for his service as senior head coach over the past 3 years. Jeremy impressed us with his excellent communication skills and the amount of effort put in to the playing group to try and reach its full potential. On behalf of the football club I would like to wish Jeremy all the best for his future endeayours and thank him for his service.

1st Grade Report

To The Belconnen Faithful,

Our 2016 pre season started at Giralang Oval in November of 2015. The 2015 result had been well documented and it was time to make a statement that we wanted to go one better in the upcoming season.

Unfortunately the early stages didn't reflect the hurt that we felt would transfer itself into inspiration as our numbers were low and some of our efforts substandard. It didn't take long for us to check ourselves and the improvement was immediate. In particular, the month of January was terrific with numbers, enthusiasm and standards all at exceptional levels.

This was punctuated with two very impressive performances during our trials with an easy and expected win over North Wagga and an emphatic and promising win over Sydney Hills Eagles. We saw this as a good thing and remained confident despite the challenge that lay ahead.

The last third of the season we felt that things started to turn. The mix seemed right, training had become energised again and after belting the Jets in the final game of the season we hit the qualifying final against Ainslie confident of an upset. What we got was the performance of the year from Ainslie. They were terrific and while our intensity and effort was there we were just not on the same level on the day. Again though, we remained confident and felt we could over come Queanbeyan and start thinking upsets again.

Sadly, this did not happen and The Tigers subjected us to another heart breaking loss. This time by 2 points in the preliminary final. All of a sudden our season was over – cue the hurt and devastation again.

One thing that must be said is that the passion, unwillingness to be beat and togetherness of the group that played that day was one that will take the group forward positively into the future. 









The 2016 season will go down as a positive one for the Belconnen Magpies with many team and individual successes. From a 60 point loss to eventual premiers Ainslie in Round 1 we managed to finish 2nd on the ladder, winning 13 games along the way and falling just 19 points short of a much deserved premiership. This season we used a total of 64 players through the reserves team alone, a statistic not common with a senior team. We also saw 7 guys play their first games for the club and 8 junior players debut in senior footy.

After a solid pre-season we somehow found ourselves in a bit of a predicament come round 1. Whilst player numbers looked promising throughout the preseason we struggled to field a side because of several injuries and unavailability's. After a few phone calls and with a couple of under 18's putting their hands up to double up we managed to get a team on the field.

Whilst this was a far from ideal start to a season we continued to build and develop our playing group and went on to play some very good footy. Along the way we enjoyed some terrific wins, none more impressive than the 240 point defeat of Gungahlin just prior to finals.

From a development perspective we saw some great signs from a number of Belconnen junior players playing their first full season of senior footy. With so many young players in the side it was important to have a group of experienced players to provide some balance and leadership. Ned Gatenby once again came to the







sure the coming year will see more improvements and success.


