Treasurer's Report



The 2017 budget was set to run at a \$14,000 loss (2016 \$17,000 loss). This year the club reported a profit of \$6,128 (after motor vehicle sale). Income for the year was under budget by \$14,287 or 4.7%, with expenditure being \$26,915 or 8.4% less than expected.

Revenue for 2017 was \$292,713 (4.7% under budget and 2.1% up on 2016).

Expenditure for 2017 was 294,085 (8.4% under budget and 3.2% down on 2016. Most categories of expenditure were under budget except for:

- AFL costs – 24.1% over budget and 11.6% down on 2016.
- Coaching expenses – 5.9% over budget and 28.9% down on 2016
- Team uniforms – 12.6% over budget and 271% up on 2016
- Ground hire – 12.3% over budget and 25.1% up on 2016

The Rising Stars season may have only yielded 5 wins from 16 games but it was a very successful season from a development and transition viewpoint. We used a total of 40 players through the year and were able to give 12 players exposure to senior football. We also played 10 under 16's boys, a few of which doubled up most weeks. Pre-season training was a new concept for a majority of the group and numbers were lower than expected. After word got out and a few boys roped in some mates we began to build a solid squad and preparations for round 1 were on track.

There were many positive signs across the first few games. We played Eastlake and Marist in our first two games and our pressure and intent was very good. After losing the first two, each by less than 10 points, we broke through for our maiden win against Gungahlin. Although it was only round 3 it felt like it was a long time coming.

Throughout the middle part of the season we managed a couple of comprehensive wins against Tuggeranong but continued to struggle against the stronger teams. We worked on a game style of attacking high risk football which at times paid off and looked great but often our skills didn't quite match our intent and we were hurt on the scoreboard.

Through the back end of the season we didn't improve our ladder position but we continued to develop our skills and game style whilst emphasising the importance of enjoyment and club culture.

One pleasing aspect of the group to highlight was their willingness and desire to play at a higher level. The 12 players that played up in the reserves this year all acquitted themselves well and were genuine in their desire to contribute to the team and club success. Likewise, the 10 under 16's who played Rising Stars all gave genuine effort and expressed a desire to learn and improve their skills and football knowledge.

As a coach and player you always want to win and even though we didn't boast the amount of talent as some other teams we displayed aggression at the contest and an unwillingness to be beaten. These traits will hold us in good stead moving forward as they are all trademarks of our senior group and an important part of our success as a club.

2017 4th Grade AFL ACT/NSW was a very strong competition, with 13 teams from across Canberra and country NSW. With a history of consistent finals appearances in 'the districts comp' for Belconnen, its difficult to measure success on anything other than results. However, in terms of growth and group development, the 4th grade Magpies had a successful year. In what was designed as a year of consolidation at the outset, the team readjusted it's focus to performances in what turned out to be a year of significant change upheaval. Although the side missed out on finals by a few 50-50 results, there are plenty of positives to take out of 2017.

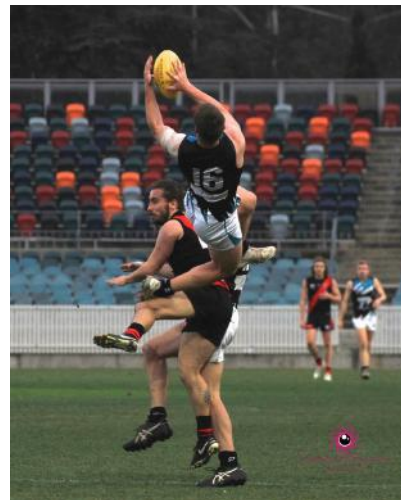

Between 1991 and 1994, he played for both 1st and 2nd grade (including the 1991 Reserve Grade Premiership and won the Reserve Grade B & F) before leaving to join the Victorian Police Force. In 2006, whilst training for a long distance triathlon event, he was struck down mysteriously and died during the run leg. He was 34 years of age.

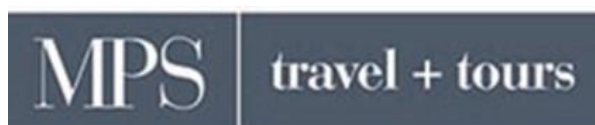
