Senior Football Co-ordinator's Report



Firstly, I would like to thank the Belconnen Magpies Football Club Board for the opportunity to be the football manger this year. In my first year of the role I have enjoyed the whole experience. There have been some challenges as expected, but also times of pure enjoyment this season and I'm already excited for what next year will bring. I'd like to especially thank the executive committee for their constant support all year.

2018 was a successful season until the last hurdle of finals. Our first grade men's and first grade women's teams finished the home and away season 2nd and 1st respectively. With the first grade women finishing as minor premiers it was disappointing to see them bow out of finals in straight sets. The impact of some key players on the sidelines and others playing through injuries it made the finals a hard task for the girls who had ultimately had a really good season up to that point. The men's story was sadly very similar, with Coach James Bennett, Ryan Turnbull, Sam Fisher and Chris York unable to play the finals series due to injury it made a tough time on the field for the young 1st grade side.

On a positive note, 2019 is looking exciting with the majority of the 2018 senior squad signing on to give next season a good shake for the silverware once again. The 2019 season is going to be a season of young players breaking through the barriers and stepping up on the field, players such as Adam Lamb, Sam O'Sullivan, Luke McGilvray, Tariku Fitzgerald-Holmes, Sam Ryan-Baker who all showed some outstanding performance throughout the year.

Our reserve grade men's side started the year on fire demolishing reigning premiers Ainslie, who hadn't lost a game in over 2 years, and then as the season went on unfortunately had injury problems as well. With a good finish towards the back of the home and away season they earned a finals spot but were unsuccessful and lost to Eastlake in the semi-finals.

Despite the issue of having only four top age players and the rest either U17s/U16s or U15s the Rising Stars had a season that impressed most. With a slow start to the season and losing multiple games by less than a goal they kicked into gear after beating the reigning premiers Queanbeyan roughly half way through the season. This win proved a vital part of the season as they then went on and qualified for finals after finishing the home and away season very strongly. Unfortunately they went down to Ainslie in the semi-finals who eventually went on to win the competition. I'd like to thank Brock Weston and his band of assistants Bobby Moroney, Lachie O'Sullivan and Carl Wenke.

This season saw the introduction of a second women's division. With our booming numbers for women's football we were able to field two sides and for a lot of the girls it was their first year of football. To see these girls go all the way into a preliminary final was outstanding and has driven many to continue on next year as it was such an enjoyable season. I would like to congratulate the amount of youth girls that played senior football this year, they all did a great job and often were the dominating players. I would also like to thank Kate Gillespie for her commitment of being the Division 2 women's coach, what a great job you did with the girls and the club is very grateful for your contribution this year.

For third grade it was a tough season. With the majority of our players playing fourth grade the

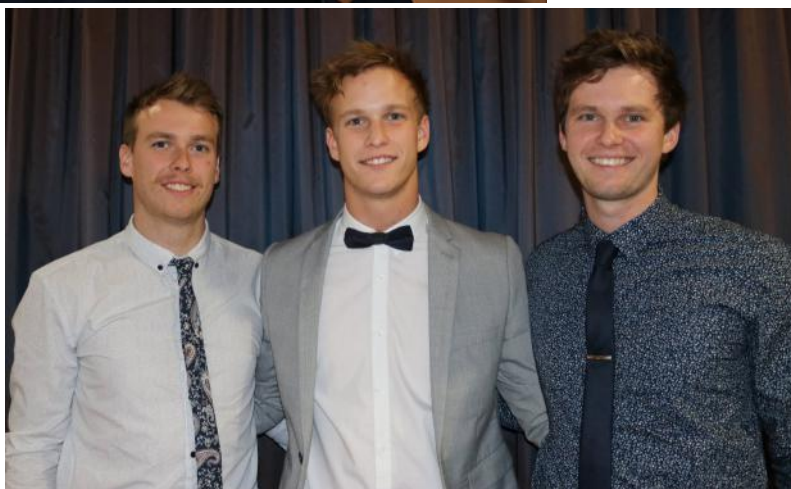

1st Grade Report

To win a premiership, along with hard work and resilience in the inevitable moments of adversity, you need to be spared the cruel blows that fate dealt our team this year. Season 2018 had us on the back foot early on with Ryan Turnbull going down with an ACL injury in round 5 and Lex Bennett requiring surgery on a broken hand in round 6. Then, at the most important time of the year, the bad luck kept on coming.

We fought through the home and away season well and managed to cope with the injuries. We ended up 2nd on the ladder with a win-loss record of 11-4 and a percentage of 187.

The finals presented us with a difficult challenge as late season injuries to Sam Fisher, Chris York, Sam O'Sullivan and me meant we were missing key players from the line-up. In the first semi-final against Ainslie, we played well in the first half but could not sustain it in the second half. Against Eastlake in the preliminary final, we started slowly but came roaring back in the 3rd quarter. This was a demonstration of the football we could play as a team, even with key personnel missing. Ultimately, we missed our opportunities and our season ended a couple of wins short of our goal.

I look back at the season with a feeling of emptiness and thoughts about what could have been. I believe we are still very much in a premiership window and we are already preparing our assault on the competition next year. With more hard work, and just a fair

share of elusive good luck, I am confident we can climb the mountain.

The season gone will hold us in good stead. We had 35 players run out in our First Grade side throughout the season. We were lucky to welcome returning players Luke Donohoe and Tom Alexander back to the club. We also had five players make their First Grade debuts for the club: Sam Cooper (becoming #579 in BMFC history), Sam Fisher (#580), Tariku Fitzgerald--Holmes (#581), Charlie Baker (#582) and Luke McGilvray (#583).

On the field, we had a number of highlights, including:

- Beau Walker finishing 3rd in the Mulrooney medal
- Len Haddrill and Jack Harper playing for the ACT Representative side
- Beau Walker, Sav Coate and Chris York selected in the AFL Canberra Team of the Year
- Alex Jones developing into an outstanding ruckman
- Sam O'Sullivan coming of age as a First Grade centre half back
- Lex Bennett playing his 250th First Grade game and leading the Mulrooney medal after 5 rounds (before breaking his hand)
- Dom Bunyan playing his 150th First Grade game
- Our co-captains in Beau Walker, Len Haddrill, Rhys Healy and Ryan Turnbull (who managed two and a half games together all year).

Off the field, the First Grade side received immense support from dedicated volunteers and support staff. We really do have the best off-field support of any team in the league and it shows in how well prepared our players are and how smoothly everything runs on game day.

On the football side, I have been lucky to have the support, expertise and significant time

commitment from a great coaching group of Tim Garrett, Tom Fisher, Aaron Tyndall, Lex Bennett, Andrew Gatenby, David Bennett and Brendan Read. On the other end of the phone, Dylan Valentine and Justin Lalor fronted up rain, hail or shine to run the messages this year. My thanks also go to Carl Wenke, Ryan Bradley, Will McInnes and Ryan Turnbull who have performed important match day roles to support the team. I also owe a debt to Jaike Altieri who took on the job of writing the match reports each week and did a fantastic job.

Thank you Terri Jamieson, Phil Batten, Pete Dunn, Paul Gunn and Anthea Hoszowski for doing everything necessary at training and on match days to assist and organise the players to play each week. Thank you to our fitness and medical team of Liam Slater, Liam (George) Phillips, Rob Jamieson, Nic Rowston and Hayley Kiermaier, who have provided excellent support to have the boys fit and returning from injuries quickly.

Behind the scenes, my job as coach has been made much easier due to the support I have received from Jack Harper and Len Haddrill as football managers, Glenn O'Sullivan as football director, and Scott Reid as President. I would also like to recognise the efforts of the rest of our Board and thank you for all of your work in making our football club such a professional and respected outfit.

To all other volunteers who have chipped in a little or a lot, thank you for the time and effort you have contributed to our great club.

This year was also a year of transition for the Magpies Sports Club and the club pulled together in trying times. My thanks to the Magpies Sports Club, and the board led by Andrew Smith, who make a significant contribution to the football club. All of our sponsors contribute to make our club a great place to play and watch football, so thank you

all for your support this year. The move to the Golf Club next year is an exciting opportunity for us to reinvigorate our after-match functions and re-engage our football family.

Finally, and most importantly, thank you to my wife Sophie and our daughter Poppy, who has just experienced her first football season, for your support of my coaching and everything that it entails!

Success is defined in many different ways. The 2018 season was a success on so many levels – we enjoyed our footy, we won a lot of games, we strengthened friendships and built a stronger foundation for next season. See you there for the ride!

It was an up and down season for the 2nd Grade side in 2018. Some strong performances were mixed with some bad loses. We often let ourselves down with a poor half or quarter, which put some winnable games out of reach. This was encapsulated by our elimination final, where playing the same side we had beaten only two weeks earlier, and down by a point at half time, we ended up losing by 53 points after a poor second half.

A lack of numbers was an issue for the team throughout the year, as it was for all lower grades throughout the club. This meant that there was minimal pressure for spots at times during the season, and meant that on numerous occasions we had to find some ring-ins or have under 18s back up after having played the game before us. A big thank you to Stan and Brock for both being very understanding and easy to deal with in a situation that at times was frustrating for all of us!

While we ended the season on a sour note, and did not have the team success that we hoped for this year, I still think it was a positive year for the second grade side. Indeed, the development of players is equally important as team success in Reserve Grade, and on that front we had a number of good stories throughout the year.

It was pleasing to see Luke McGilvray, Michael McQueen and Charlie Baker make their debuts in first grade this year, which was reward for some strong form in the 2s. Luke cemented a first grade over the second half of the year, which, after serving a long apprenticeship in

2nd Grade, was a credit to Luke's performances and a good development story for the club.

A number of young players, such as Will Ryan, Oscar Smyth, Fraser Miller, Jaike Altieri and Kieran Ruyg played their first full season of senior football for the club, and displayed their potential at stages throughout the year. I look forward to even further improvement from this group next season.

The lack of numbers also gave the opportunity to play Senior Football for a number of Rising Stars players, all of whom acquitted themselves well. For the top aged Rising Stars players, this time spent around the second grade group should help ease the transition to the Senior Squad next year. It also enabled us to give a taste of senior football to some particularly talented bottom age (or even younger) Rising Stars players, which will only help improve their games as they hopefully push towards the First Grade side over the next couple of years.

From a team perspective, we had two stand-out wins across the season, knocking off Ainslie, who at that stage had not been beaten in second grade for 2 years, and beating Eastlake with a team featuring a few ring-ins as we were very short on numbers that week.

Importantly, I believe we created an environment at the Second Grade level that was enjoyable to be a part of, while also embracing the hard work that is required to both improve and feel a sense of achievement as a footballer. Credit goes to the playing group for this. Numbers at training were good through the year, the team trained hard and listened eagerly to what the coaches had to say. Once we finished the hard work, and irrespective of the result, we enjoyed each other's company. This made life easy for me as the coach and made the footy club a fun place to be around.

There are a number of people that deserve thanks for their assistance to me and the 2nd grade playing group over the season. First of all, thanks to my Assistant Coaches: Chris Calvert, John Gregory and Carl Wenke. Each of you offered your own perspectives on how footy should be played and were a big factor in creating the environment focused on enjoyment combined with hard work that I wanted to create. The first grade coaching staff, led by senior coach James Bennett, were a great source of knowledge for me, and I learnt a lot from being around this group throughout the year.

With last year's co-captains both unavailable this year, Tom Baker stepped into the role and I thank him for the help he provided me. When Tom was unavailable, we had a rotational policy for the captaincy, and being able to reward certain players and expose them to leadership positions will only help the club going forward.

Thanks also to Kieran Ferns and Elliott Jordan, who both agreed to help this year. Kieran signed on to run the bench on game day and found himself having the occasional stint in the Coaches Box and sneaking in a game when we were short. Elliott agreed to be the team's runner, yet often found himself running the bench and even had to umpire a pre-season game for us on short notice.

As usual, our support staff did a mountain of work throughout the year. Physio Liam Phillips, the Strength and Conditioning team lead by Liam Slater and the Sports Trainers under Anthea Hoszowski did a great job in ensuring players were able to return to the field as quickly as possible after injuries and were on hand to assist with any issues that arose on game day.

Club stalwarts in team manager Phil Batten and team hydration steward (amongst many other roles!) Pete Dunn spent so much time at

the Nest that it felt like they both lived there. I immensely valued the variety of roles that these two fulfilled for Second Grade team, and it allowed the players to focus purely on playing to the best of their ability every weekend. Terri Jamieson (First Grade manager) and Paul Gunn (Timekeeper) also gave up their time to help Second Grade, and I thank them for their continued support.

Thanks also to some key off field people in Scott Reid (President), Glenn O'Sullivan (Football Director) and Jack Harper (Football Manager). These three were always happy to assist me wherever they could, and I was appreciative of all the advice they offered me during the year.

Last but not least, thanks to my partner Erin for her support throughout the year. She was incredibly understanding of the significant time commitment that comes with coaching a football side, and as always, her perspective (from outside the football bubble) on certain issues was greatly appreciated!

Congrats to all the award winners and I look forward to seeing everyone again in 2019.

2018 proved to be a long season full of surprises, challenges, laughs and frustrations for coaches and players alike.

After a condensed pre-season we showed some positive signs early and found ourselves in games for long periods but unable to break through for a maiden victory.

After the first 4 rounds we remained winless and endured 3 heartbreaking losses by less than a goal but in round 5 on a muddy Holt 102 we scrapped our way to our first win accounting for the reigning premiers Marist. This was followed by two heavy defeats and by the halfway mark of the season we were struggling, sitting equal last on the ladder on 1 win, 6 losses.

Our 8th and 9th games against Gungahlin and Tuggeranong were solid wins and would prove to be the turning point of our season. We would go on to win 7 of our last 9 games, accounting for both eventual grand finalists and our record of 8 wins 8 losses was good enough for our young team to scrape into 4th spot and play finals. 2 months earlier this result would have seemed unattainable but form and momentum saw us get another crack at the top teams.

Our finals experience was short and sharp as we were over run by a fresh Ainslie outfit who would eventually go on to beat the heavily favoured Queanbeyan in the Grand Final with a kick after the siren.

A special mention needs to go to the Rising

Stars players. In addition to the 16 games they played in the Rising stars competition, most doubled up and played under 17's on the same day including 13 players who played under 17's the day before playing in the Rising Stars final against an Ainslie side who had no players backing up. It wasn't only the younger players who played additional games as some of the older players regularly doubled up and played 3rd grade who were struggling for consistent numbers. This highlights the workload that this group of players endured throughout season 2018. One big positive is that we have a very talented group of footballers that will have another 2 seasons of Rising Stars football to set themselves up to be the next core playing group for our senior club.

From a coaching perspective I was pleased by the physical efforts displayed by the players this season. Because of the differing ages (15-19), skill levels and abilities within the playing group much of our time at training was spent developing skills and focussing on game sense and awareness drills rather than game style or structure based training. This meant that most games were simply scrapped out and we relied heavily on our contested ball work and our willingness to get from contest to contest. In the coming seasons these boys will be exposed to more game style and structure work within our senior system.

There were several individual seasons to make comment on. Max Monaghan and Daniel Sim were both involved in the GWS Giants Academy Program, with Max doing very well being selected for the NSW ACT Rams and playing in the U16's National Carnival. He would have also debuted in First Grade as a 16 year old had it not been for an untimely injury. Thomas Simpson and John Rees also enjoyed very good seasons with Thomas taking out the league U17's Best & Fairest award and John finishing a couple of votes behind.

Adding to these great individual seasons both

the junior clubs had 5 players (who played Rising Stars) represent the ACT in the Under 15 Nationals. Mackinley Miller, Ryan Murphy, Harry Ryan-Baker, Will Thomas and Leigh McKay all acquitted themselves well and will be future stars of the club.

I was fortunate to have some very capable assistant coaches to help with what is a challenging age group to coach.

Bobby Moroney and Lachie O'Sullivan were at almost every session and both spent additional time assisting individuals in skills and strength and fitness areas. Carl Wenke and Blake Ford were also helpful and their time and efforts were greatly appreciated.

Thank you to Jo Foster who once again gave her time and energy to manage on game days and to Emma Simpson for her ability to communicate with the playing group which was an important part of us getting a team on the field week in week out.

Thanks to Daina, Maddy, Cody, Dylan, Liam and all the trainers and physios that have assisted the team throughout the season.

Finally thank you to the players, parents, coaches and partners that turned up week in week out to training and games.

I sincerely hope you all got some positives out of the season and are looking forward to continuing your development and involvement in the senior system.

This year was a testing and trying year for everyone involved. The first biggest hurdle we had to overcome this year was being notified two weeks before the start of the season that we have been moved from fourth grade to third grade. I was a little bit nervous about telling the players, as being the new coach, I thought that the players might just turn and walk. Due to their credit the players stuck by me and the club and we were in for a long year.

This year there was a total of 59 players that played in 3rd grade, ages varying from 15 to 34. The age gap was always going to be a challenge as you are a father figure to some and a mate to others. In terms of the ability of the players, there was a large gap as well. From first year players or players returning from a long break, right through to players that have almost played 300 games for the club.

The first four rounds saw us go down by ten goals or more each match, but even in these situations, the team didn't stop competing until the final siren. 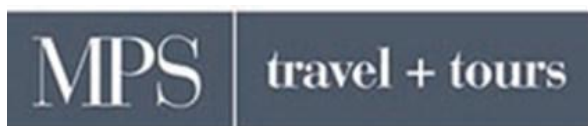
