### Treasurer's Report

2020 was an interesting year given COVID-19 and the implications it had on the Football Club. The revenue for the Football Club was only slightly down on the 2019 figures, which is a fantastic result. This is because our amazing sponsors continued to support the Football Club financially despite the uncertainty surrounding their own economic situation and the 2020 football season.

As mentioned in previous reports, sponsorship is the biggest contributor to revenue, and it was fantastic to see so many sponsors stand by the football club in what was a difficult year. A huge thank you should go out to all sponsors for their continued support, in particular the Belconnen Magpies Sports Club.

Expenses were more than halved in 2020 compared to 2019. This is because of COVID-19 implications that saw the season shortened and the following changes:

A reduction in league affiliation fees and insurances

Ground hire fees were not charged from April

A league wide agreement that no players would be paid for their participation in the 2020 season

The departure of the single football club employee, acting in a full-time role, being replaced by a casual employee

The profit posted in the final 2020 accounts is **\$146,730.06**. After the last couple of financial years, this is a fantastic result for the Football Club. The bank balance and the net asset position are all looking a lot healthier.

Items in the Profit & Loss Statement warranting further explanation are listed below:

Other Revenue – (\$27,117.17): Includes \$20,000 received as a Cash Flow Boost payment for employers as part of the Government's COVID-19 response. The

remaining income in this account should have been brought to account in the previous financial year.

**Abnormal Item** – \$17,891.74: These expenses are related to the previous financial year and should have been accrued in the 2019 accounts.

Thank you to all the wonderful people that volunteer their time and effort to help run the Belconnen Magpies Football Club. I would like to make special mention of a few well deserving people. First, Jacqueline Spence, who went above and beyond what is expected by the secretary whilst the football club was without an employee. Second, Dan Posch and Ryan Bradley for their efforts with the sponsorship portfolio. Third, Glenn O'Sullivan, Ethan Bartlett and the team at SPA Accounting for their continued accounting support. Fourth, Emma Simpson for her assistance and clear communication throughout the year. Last, the executive and the rest of the board that supported me in my role as treasurer.

Well done to all the successful premiership winning teams in 2020 and here is hoping for more success in the years to follow.

#### Senior Football Co-ordinator's Report

Season 2020 was the season we almost did not have!

BMFC had appointed new coaches in four of its seven teams, with Brock Weston appointed Senior Coach, Lachie O'Sullivan as 2<sup>nd</sup> grade coach, Rickie Dolliver as Rising Stars coach and Bobby Moroney as 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Women's coach. There was a great deal of excitement about the season and the players were eager to get started.

With smoke still lingering in the air, early training sessions were challenging, but our teams persevered. Then we were faced with our competition being delayed for a number of weeks due to the global pandemic and we all wondered whether we would play at all. Thankfully, with a great deal of hard work and negotiation between the AFL, ACT Government and the Club Presidents we were finally given news of a 10-round season with a three-week finals series.

Training began in small groups of 10, which made team cohesiveness challenging. Added into the mix was mandatory safety protocols to keep the everyone safe. But with the hunger of the footy season driving them, our coaching and support staff worked hard to make sure our players could continue to prepare for the season ahead.

As Round 1 rapidly approached, there was another setback with COVID restrictions in the ACT not being relaxed to allow competition to commence as planned. Thankfully, Queanbeyan Tigers offered to host Round 1 (that was scheduled to be played at the Nest) at Allinsure Sports Ground and our season was alive again!

Weather and COVID presented challenges for the Club throughout the season, with Round 6 washed out due to heavy rain. The enthusiasm of our community continued and we soldiered on through changing restrictions to host the final three rounds of footy at our much-loved Nest.

Our 1st grade men debuted 15 players across with season, with some promising Juniors taking regular spots in the side. Once again, injury caused some instability in the group, but given the depth of talent in our Club we were able to continue to compete at a high standard, going down in the preliminary final against a very strong Queanbeyan outfit who went on to win the competition.

Our 2<sup>nd</sup> grade men continued to build on their team cohesiveness and skills whilst also supporting our 1<sup>st</sup> grade side, training together as a senior squad across the year. They were the team to beat across the year with their skills, determination and teamwork ending the home and away season undefeated. A small hurdle in the semi-final gave the boys the hunger and drive to manage their discipline and deliver ultimate success with a wonderful spine-tingling win against Ainslie in the Grand Final, fighting up until the final siren.

The Rising Stars were a young squad this season, led by a handful of older and more experienced players. They were unlucky to miss out of finals footy, but showed some promising form for Season 2021.

This year we had such strong numbers that we were able to field two community teams in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade competitions. Injury across the Club caused some headaches with selection, but our 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade squad fought hard across a somewhat disjointed season, with byes and washout rounds. Brendan Trevaskis, with the assistance of Drew Somerville has built a fantastic sense of community among the players and we hope that this will continue to grow.

Our 2<sup>nd</sup> grade women, similar to the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>

grade teams had a disjointed season but worked hard every week at training and on game day. Our 2<sup>nd</sup> grade women also supported our 1<sup>st</sup> grade women and volunteered with other teams across the season. There was a great deal of laughter and fun and exciting footy had by all.

With a disjointed start to the season, our 1st grade women were determined to achieve great things this season. Our two women's sides trained three nights a week early in the season to build on their skills and fitness. Across the season our women stumbled against Queanbeyan, but still managed to come out of the home and away season with the double chance. Going down to Queanbeyan in the semi-final only made them more determined and went into the Grand Final with great excitement about the challenge ahead. Our women looked strong from the centre bounce and for the first time in recent history beat Queanbeyan to hoist the premiership cup for BMFC. A truly wonderful way to end the 2020 season.

For a year that was so disjointed and challenging our players, coaches, support staff and volunteers provided an unforgettable football year.

A massive thank you to our valuable and loyal sponsors who continued to support our great Club despite not being able to support our teams in person at games. Our hard-working Board should also be given a huge thank you for their tireless efforts to provide such a fantastic Club atmosphere for our players.

### 1st Grade Report

#### Coach - Brock Weston Manager - William McInnes

2020 will be remembered by all as the year humanity was challenged mentally, physically and emotionally. So much has been said about the impact of Covid-19 and locally we are all too familiar with the suffocating effect of the summer bushfires and the challenges they posed.

My appointment in October was an extremely proud moment personally and I very much looked forward to continuing to build on the platform created by my predecessors.

Preseason was very positive from a numbers perspective as we saw 71 players train across a four week block. The bushfires then took hold, forcing us to improvise and adapt with many sessions forced indoors. It became evident that the impact on our group could linger so we began to plan some catch up sessions to ensure we wouldn't be behind the 8 ball come March. After a solid intra club hit out which provided the coaching staff with a positive outlook we hit another snag. Unfortunately no one could predict the impact of the Covid 19 epidemic and the subsequent lock down.

This period would prove difficult to navigate for many reasons. The unknown was frustrating and whilst we were less impacted from a social aspect compared to other states, it was definitely a challenge to keep the group in contact and keep all players engaged and positive about a return to the field. The green light to return to some form of training was greeted with enthusiasm as our squad started to train in pairs, then groups of eight. Our leaders took the reigns and worked through a program developed by Slats, with most players logging their runs on Strava, which created some healthy competition.

As many leagues across the country pulled the pin on the 2020 season, it became evident that there was an abundance of quality players looking for a club. The obvious temptation was to open our doors and add some quality to our squad but there was going to have to be a balance between recruiting and development, a balance that I believed we nailed as a club. This large pool of players without a home saw us net quality players Mitch Maguire, Nick Eynaud and Josh Buchanan, all of whom fitted in seamlessly adding value on and off the field. The addition of these quality players helped to offset the impact of the loss of players through the off season. The departure list was significant with the likes of Jack Harper, Chris York, Jeff

Dowdell, Sam Fisher, Taz Fitzgerald-Holmes, Rhys Hartwig and Beau Walker, to name a few.

The announcement of a 10 games plus finals season was a welcome one and although we had an interrupted preseason we felt we were primed and ready to go. With individual match reports available in the newsletter some of the highlights of the season were: 16 players making their senior debut for the club, including 7 local juniors, finishing the season third with six wins and three losses (one washout), Biggest win 109 points against Gungahlin.

A pleasing aspect of the 2020 season was the rise of our junior players. Thomas Simpson, Mackinley Miller, John Rees and Max Monaghan, in his second full season, took incredible strides in their development and filled important roles in the team throughout the season. Seb Quirk and Brendan Egan were welcomed into the Belconnen family from Marist and had an immediate impact, hopefully paving the way for their school mates in future seasons.

Success can be measured in many ways and although we didn't achieve the ultimate goal in a first grade premiership we did however successfully navigate a very difficult season. As a club we came away with a reserve grade and first grade women's premierships which were both outstanding achievements by the respective coaches and playing groups. Now that the dust has settled I can go away from the 2020 season with a sense of pride and an overwhelming sense of accomplishment. My priorities for the season were to blood youth, create an enjoyable environment that the players want to come back to and to win.

We ticked 2 out of 3 boxes.

### Women's 1st Grade Report

Coach - Bobby Moroney Manager - Kylie McKay

Who said that 2020 was a bad year?! After the most disjointed and uncertain year ever, our Women's First Grade team found a way to overcome every obstacle put before them. Whether it was an inability to train at all, the unfortunate possibility of a cancelled season, restricted to training in groups of 10, not having a football oval available due to flooded grounds, or playing a side that had only lost once in its previous 25 games dating back to 2018; we were ultimately crowned the AFL Canberra UNSW Senior Women's 2020 Premiers!

Despite the occasional smoky skies, our preseason started off extremely well. We regularly had 30-40 players at training, and there was always a positive vibe about the upcoming season. With a new coaching group, the early focus was to ensure that the playing group were prepared to challenge themselves and be willing to get outside of their comfort zones, while the coaches needed to understand what the players wanted out of their football and work towards building an environment that everyone genuinely wanted to be a part of.

From a game perspective, we made some changes in the way that we wanted to transition the football from defence into attack, and raised the expectation that players can't settle with performing one act well. Instead, they needed to provide multiple efforts (offensively and defensively) in order to move the football. It was also highlighted very early that in order to get the most out of ourselves (coaches and players), we all needed to have a goal – individually and collectively. This goal would ensure that we maintained focus regardless of what happened in the future. To assist with this, I shared a quote with our squad that became our motivation for the entire season; "To achieve something you

never had, you need to do something you have never done". Little did we know that there was going to be many instances where we needed to do something we had never done. Thanks COVID-19!

When we were finally able to return following the initial COVID-19 restrictions, it was important to me that we worked as a complete Women's squad in the lead up to the season finally starting. I always felt that we needed everyone's involvement in order to build a strong bond within the group and to have a clear understanding of the style of football we wanted to play. Having a mix of First Grade and Second Grade players training in small groups would also help when the opportunity arrived for someone to step into the First Grade team.

With a shortened season, it was always going to be crucial to get off to a good start and despite a loss in Round 4 to Queanbeyan in torrential rain, we would hit the half way point of the season with a 4-1 record. It was stressed regularly that the score, regardless of result, wasn't important. We couldn't control the result once the game was over, but we could control what we learnt from the game and how we improved from week to week. We took this same approach after every game and it certainly shaped how much we improved throughout the second half of our season.

The run to the finals started really well. Two convincing wins brought us back up against Queanbeyan again. Unfortunately that was our worst game all year. Scoreless across three quarters, and a 12 goal loss with only two weeks before the finals. We could very easily have sat back and thought that 2020 just wasn't going to be our year, but we definitely thrived at overcoming challenges this year. After the Queanbeyan game, we picked ourselves up, dusted ourselves off, reviewed, reset and finished the home and away season with a big win over Eastlake to secure second place on the ladder.

Ahead of the finals we remained positive and felt that we had the structure in place to complement an extremely talented and confident group. We just needed to put four quarters together. In the Semi Final we allowed Queanbeyan to control the play too much in the first half and played without the freedom and confidence from the previous week. Despite a better finish to the game it ultimately would be the third time we lost to them this year. The Preliminary Final against Eastlake was a lot better with our girls playing to their strengths. An outstanding four-quarter effort proved what we were capable of when we kept to our structures, trusted each other, and played without fear of failure. Following our win, there was a distinct resolve within the group that despite three losses already to Queanbeyan we still felt that our best football would challenge them and give us a huge chance at celebrating 20 years of BMFC Women's Football in the best way possible.

Timing is everything in football, and as long as you play your best game in the last game, amazing things will happen. Four perfect quarters, pressure at every contest, and a commitment to never stop running until the end is what we delivered. There was not a single second that we felt unable to achieve our goal. It was a Grand Final performance that will be forever remembered and undoubtedly inspire many juniors to wear the black, white and teal.

A huge congratulations to Emily Pease who was selected by the GWS Giants at pick 29 in the 2020 AFL Women's draft. Peasey is an outstanding talent who loves to be challenged. She's strong on both sides of her body, can play in defence or attack, and we can't wait to see her debut in 2021.

Thank you to Jo Foster and Shelby O'Neale who were our assistant coaches this year, but also to Alex Thompson and Chloe Pellow for

getting my messages out to the girls. We were lucky to have Dave Pease capturing every big moment and Paul Gunn for his time keeping. I also want to highlight Kylie McKay for her continued support of the girls as our Manager. A lasting memory will be the joy on Kylie's face when we knew the girl's had won the Grand Final.

The 2020 season will certainly be one to remember for our squad but also the BMFC community more broadly. As we know, the opportunity to win a premiership does not come around every day and what we were able to achieve as a team and club on Grand Final day was truly special.

After an extended pre-season due to the competition being pushed back, we finished the home and away season undefeated and on top of the ladder. With several new faces joining the club or progressing from the U18s the depth this year was as strong as the club has seen in some time. The reserves team fielded a whopping 54 players throughout the season all of whom were able to contribute to the overall success of the year. Congratulations to everyone who made their 2<sup>nd</sup> grade debut this season.

Whilst the season finished on an extraordinary high as a team, there were several stand out individual moments throughout the year. Firstly, to Ned Gatenby who early in the season decided to hang up the boots to focus on his coaching and make way for younger developing players. Ned retires holding the games record for 2<sup>nd</sup> grade with 198 games. Ned's been a fantastic role model on and off the field for many years and is a great example of someone who exemplifies the Belconnen behaviours and values. With Ned finishing up, the opening market for the 2km time trial is now wide open. Congratulations on a terrific career Ned and thank you for teaching myself and other younger members of the club the Belconnen way.

Additionally, congratulations must go to Brad Posch who chalked up his 100<sup>th</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> grade game this season. Posch has been a fantastic servant of the club on and off the field from captaining his u18s side to a premiership in his early days to now sitting on the club's board. Posch has been a solid contributor throughout his 2<sup>nd</sup> grade career, often given the job to lock down on the opposition's dangerous small forward. Posch also stepped into an Assistant Coaching role after suffering an injury and was able to provide great insight in the box as well as taking care of the backline. Thanks for all your help and support Posch!

Moving onto big brother Dan Posch, who had another terrific individual season taking out the league's leading goal kicker and best & fairest medals. A wonderful personal achievement and recognition for all your hard work. Whilst Poschy was able to often kick numerous goals and provide a strong target up forward, it is his on-field leadership and direction for younger players that will be of most value for the club moving into the future. Well done on a great year Poschy, we look forward to seeing you back out on the field again next year.

As for the season, we had a combination of tough, grinding wins and overwhelmingly convincing wins. The close, tough wins really helped set us up and fill the side with confidence heading into finals. It was really pleasing that throughout the year different players were able to step up when it counted and really put a solid team performance together. Our backline were outstanding all season, only letting in roughly 200 points from 12 games (compared to our 800+). As a result of our backline's leadership and calmness under pressure, our generals Sam Cooper, Charles Miller and Tynan Doyle were able to intercept and defend, allowing the likes of Ozzy Smyth, Angus Collins, Michael McQueen and Paddy Horan to rebound with speed and penetration. The backline's never die attitude, led by the fearless Joey Kenna really rubs off onto the rest of the team and was often the deciding factor in close games.

Our forward line was a good mix of new and experienced players. Dan Posch, Benson Ochieng and Sam Young consistently provided strong targets in the forward 50 and were rarely beaten in the air. Their ability to consistently compete and bring the ball to ground bought players like Nic Hay and Jacob Taylor into the game, who both had fantastic seasons. CJ and Moons were able to provide a high lead up target for the midfield but also able to apply the necessary pressure closer to goal to cause the opposition to turn over the ball.

Finally, our midfield led by Captain Ryan Bradley and experienced head Djali Bloomfield (who also stepped up to captain the side for several weeks) provided the club's future stars with fantastic development opportunities. The likes of John Rees,

Brendan Egan and Fraser Miller all played significant roles through the midfield and all had breakout seasons at senior level. Zac Lindsay also took his game to the next level, playing with confidence and taking the game on. Our ability to win the ruck and give our mids first use was a real strength of ours this year, kudos to Tom Fekete and Hamish Healy. Our midfield's capability to be first to the ball and take the simple first option gave us a predictability and simplicity to move the ball with pace. Luke McGilvray's speed around the contest was such an advantage in tight and sluggish games, his ability to break the line and deliver the footy to outside runners is terrific.

Another fantastic positive this season was the opportunity to reward strong performances in the 2s with games in 1<sup>st</sup> grade, we had 16 debutants in 1<sup>st</sup> grade which were all special moments for the individual and the club. We're in a great position as a club when experienced players can put aside their disappointment of not playing at the highest level and take the opportunity to really invest in the development of younger up and coming players in the 2s.
