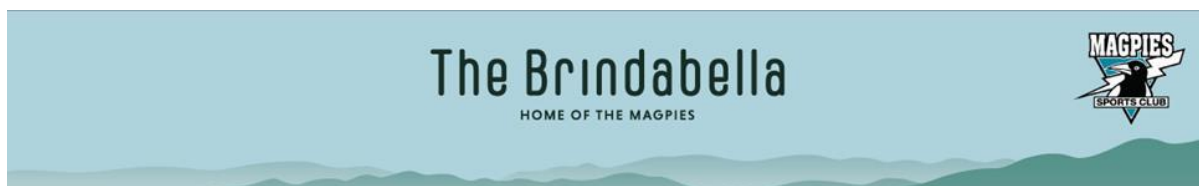

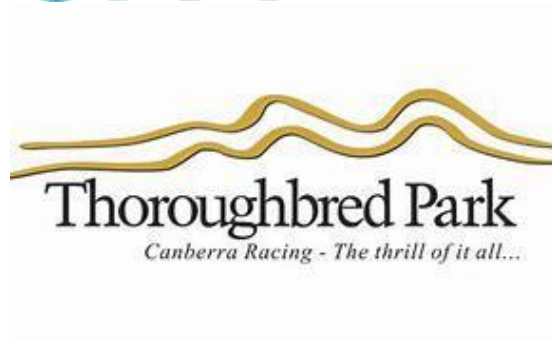

## President's report

## Treasurer's report

2021 was another testing year for many at the football club with COVID-19 cutting the season short.

The revenue for the Football Club was up from the COVID-19 affected 2020 figures, which is a good result. This is largely thanks to our amazing club sponsors. A special thank you must go to the Belconnen Magpies Sports Club and their board who managed to increase the grant given to the football club in the 2021 financial year. As mentioned in previous reports, sponsorship is the biggest contributor to revenue, and it was fantastic to see so many sponsors continuing to support the football club in 2021. A huge thank you should go out to all sponsors for their continued support.

Expenses increased by more than \$100,000 in 2021 compared to 2020. This is because the 2021 season saw a return of the following expenses:

- Non-discounted AFL NSW/ACT affiliation fees
- Non-discounted medical expenses
- Coaching expenses
- Player payments
- An employee for the full 12 month period of the 2021 financial year.

The profit posted in the final 2021 accounts is \$64,155.06. This is another fantastic result for the Football Club. The bank balance and the net asset position continue to look healthy.

Items in the Profit & Loss Statement warranting further explanation are listed below:

- Other Revenue – (\$20,304.55): Includes \$20,000 received as a COVID-19 Business Support payment as part of the Government's COVID-19 response.

Thank you to all the wonderful people that volunteer their time and effort to help run the Belconnen Magpies Football Club. I would like to make special mention of a few well deserving people. Third, Emma Simpson for her assistance and clear communication throughout the year. Last, the executive and the rest of the board that supported me in my role as treasurer.

## Senior football report

After the strangeness of the 2020 season, 2021 will go down on paper as an even greater challenge, with the first cancelled AFL Canberra season since the competition began in 1924. That said, unlike the 2020 season with its late start, lack of crowds and influx of players from cancelled leagues, for much of the year, 2021 felt almost normal. But then the Delta outbreak arrived, the ACT went into an extended lockdown, and that was it.

This was a frustrating result for all the people involved in the Football Club, but none more so than the Playing and Coaching groups, whose hard work had positioned the club as a premiership threat in almost every Grade. The risk of burnout from putting in all this effort and not getting the opportunity to benefit from this hard work is something that will need to be managed carefully in 2022.

In fact, maybe the only, and very minor, benefit from the season not reaching its conclusion is the ability to analyse the way the Senior Football program was run without the result of one knockout game, or one poor quarter, having an undue influence.

And upon reflection, enormous strides were made in key areas in 2021.

Firstly, the establishment of a Player Welfare Framework was a welcome improvement, especially given the toll the last two years has taken on many people. Thanks to the Football Club Board and Sam Ryan-Baker in particular, for driving this.

The increased focus on junior development was another highlight. New initiatives were implemented, such as whole of club junior trainings and coaching forums. These, combined with the usual ideas such as senior players attending junior trainings, outlined a template for exactly how junior development needs to be done year after year at the BMFC.

A number of talented Under 18s players were given games in First and Second Grade in 2021, and all showed themselves to have bright futures at the Football Club. Giving these players an opportunity at the higher level is important for many reasons and the entire coaching staff deserve praise for how these transitions between the grades were managed throughout the year. This focus on development bought almost immediate results, and a comparison of the 2021 First Grade side compared with the one that played the 2019 Grand Final shows how quickly the team has managed to be rebuilt.

We continued to always remain competitive – a great effort given the number of club legends that have retired or moved on since that day.

This influx of youth had the added benefit of producing an exciting style of play in 2021. The frequent chains of quick handballs to release players into space and the constant taking the game on made for great viewing, and it was clear the team were all on the same page in how they wanted to move the ball whatever the score line or position on the ground.

Special credit must go to returning First Grade Coach James Bennett for overseeing all of this. The Club is fortunate to have someone of James' calibre, with attributes to Coach at a far higher level than AFL Canberra, being such a loyal Belconnen person. Many of the initiatives outlined above were successful due to James' hard work and considerable skill in player development and game plan implementation.

Lach O'Sullivan returned as Second Grade Coach, and the way the side strung together strong performances week after week, despite an at times considerable injury list, reflects the work that Lach puts in. Lach also ran much of the pre-Christmas training, a step up in responsibility for him and something that he handled exceptionally well.

Nick Eynaud as Under 18s Coach, and Sam Telfer as 3rd Grade Coach, joined the coaching group for the first time in 2021. Both struck a nice balance of being relatable but also respected within their playing groups. Special credit to Nick for the active role he played in junior development – always encouraging his players to seek opportunities at the higher level, even if it was detrimental to the short-term prospects of his own team.

Aside from the sterling job done by all the Players and Coaches, there were many others who deserve thanks for their efforts this year. Olivia Dawson, Liam Slater, Dominik Turner and the rest of the Elite team gave the playing group the best possible conditioning, injury treatment and rehab services. The stop start nature of the last two years has presented this group additional challenges and they handled them incredibly well.

Thank you to all the Sponsors, whose efforts are essential in the Club being able to function at the level it currently does. That these contributions continued during such a tough period for many businesses is an acknowledgement of the amazing loyalty this group continues to show to the Football Club.

## First grade men's report

2021 was another successful season for our First Grade side, with significant achievements on and off the field. Ultimately, the season was cancelled prior to finals as Canberra went into lockdown for the COVID-19 public health emergency.

While we did not get the chance to play finals footy and push for a premiership, we were able to achieve some impressive on-field results and continue to make our club a great community of which to be a part.

We were well served by our Captain Jack Baker who, despite suffering a broken wrist halfway through the season, continued to lead the players very effectively. Luke Wharton and Len Haddrill, as our vice-captains, also led the team well throughout the season.

We were in a top 2 position when the season was called off, with a 9-2 record from 11 games. We had beaten all of our top 4 opponents, only dropping 2 games to Ainslie (4th) when we were undermanned and missing some of our top-end players. Our season highlights included:

- A great win in Round 3 over Queanbeyan by 15 points in a top of the table clash,
- A come from behind win against Ainslie in Round 9, overturning a 16 point deficit at three quarter time by kicking 4 goals to 2 points in the last quarter
- 3 wins from 3 games against Eastlake across the season.

While our team has seen a changing of the guard over recent seasons, our side continues to grow and improve, despite getting younger. In 2021, we had 35 players play first grade across the season, with 7 debutants:

On the field we also had several individual performances that deserve particular recognition:

- Luke Wharton finishing 3rd in the league medal count
- Sam Glyde leading our goal-kicking with 31 goals in 7 games (closely followed by Mitch Mooney with 29 goals from 10 games in a career-best season)
- The continued growth of our younger players into quality senior footballers led by Seb Quirk, Max Monaghan and Tom Simpson
- Our ruck-forward 'hybrids' in Blake Chapman and Alex Jones maturing into a formidable combination and providing another tall forward option behind the consistently dominant Andrew Dess

- Our greatly improved backline, led by huge development from Paddy Horan and Sam Cooper.

## First grade women's report

Our Women's First Grade side came into the 2021 season with not only a strong desire to repeat our success of 2020, but an excitement to play a full season after the interrupted and shortened previous season. With consistently high numbers coming to training, players coming up from our junior club and new players regularly looking to join our squad, we were able to pull together an excellent preseason and set ourselves up for a big year.

In order to cover the loss of several players from our premiership side, and prevent becoming predictable, there needed to be some positional changes which resulted in players taking a little time to settle into their new roles. Despite this, we had a very good first month of football that included the opportunity to unfurl our 2020 Premiership flag and was bookended with a win against Gungahlin to open the season and a phenomenal team performance to set up a huge win against Ainslie.

Having established a solid platform in the first month, we set ourselves a goal to consolidate on our initial efforts and ensure that we took control of our own destiny. The middle month of football started really strong with some huge wins, but it was the movement of the football and the teamwork that was most promising.

Unfortunately weather caused the game to be postponed, and it set the scene for what was to come over the next month.

Despite not being able to field the same 20 players for consecutive weeks throughout the first 6 rounds, our confidence leading into the first bye of the year was really high. The quality of our football was excellent, every player that came up from our Second Grade team was performing extremely well, we had five of the top ten league goal scorers, and sat comfortably on top of the ladder. However, constant poor weather started to have an unwelcome impact with ground closures preventing us from being able to effectively prepare for each game.

Over the last 7 rounds of the season we were only able to train on a full football ground 8 times, and prior to three games we were limited to just one training session.

Even though our season didn't finish the way we wanted, there were some outstanding highlights. We celebrated Adol Aboui, Tiarne Reid and Maggie Gorham reaching the 50-game club.

Hannah Walleth had another great year, kicking 32 goals and finishing 2nd in the league. Maggie Gorham and Ally Morphett came equal third in the league Best and Fairest.

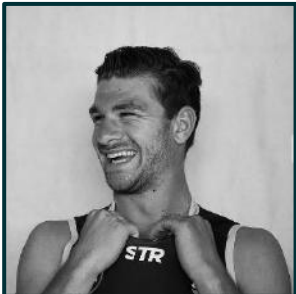

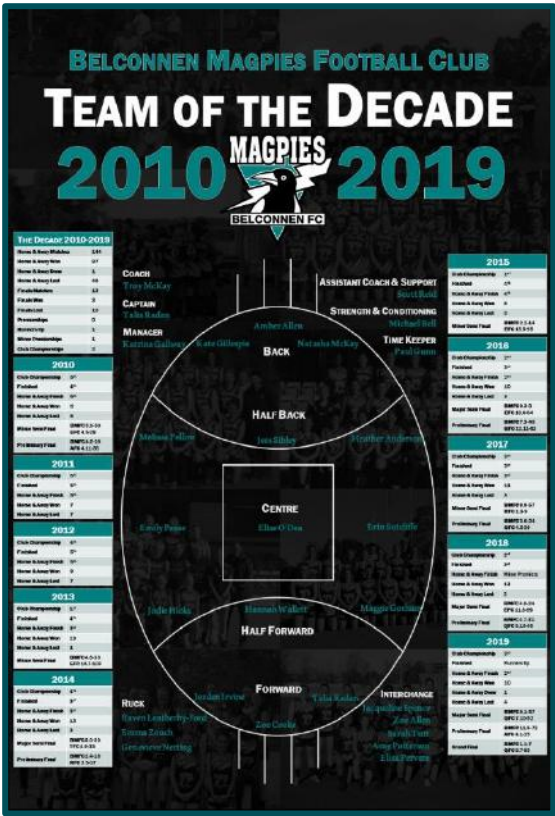

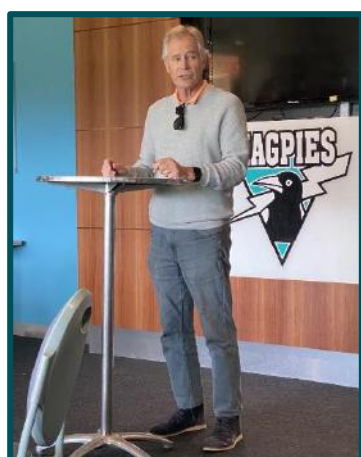
## 50 years of football in Belconnen and special acknowledgement to Rob Goddard
