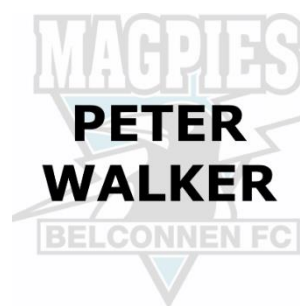

Treasurer's report

The 2022 financial year saw an increase in revenue and expenses as Australia committed to opening up post COVID-19 lockdowns. The increase in revenue is largely a result of increased sponsorship. A special thank you must go to the Belconnen Magpies Sports Club and their board who managed to continue their increased grant amount to the football club. It's fantastic to see so many sponsors continuing to support the football club and some new ones contributing in 2022. A huge thank you should go out to all sponsors for their support.

The increase in expenses was largely driven by increased player payments as the club made every effort to retain and recruit players in both the male and female groups. The club also made an investment to further redevelop the Nest having plans and costings completed for upgrades to lighting, female change rooms and a function space.

The football club has posted a small profit in the 2022 accounts. This is a good result, particularly given a small loss was budgeted. The bank balance and the net asset position continue to look healthy.

Items in the Profit & Loss Statement warranting further explanation are listed below:

- Other Revenue – (\$28,092): Includes \$28,000 received as a COVID-19 Business Support payment as part of the Government's COVID-19 response.

Without the above COVID-19 Business Support payment the football club would've posted a loss for the 2022 financial year.

Thank you to all the wonderful people that volunteer their time and effort to help run the Belconnen Magpies Football Club. Recruiting and retaining volunteers to assist the football club is an ongoing challenge. For every person that volunteers their time – thank you and I hope to see you next year.

Well done to everyone involved in the 2022 season and congratulations to those that achieved a Premiership – here's hoping there are a few more at the end of the 2023 season.

First grade women's report

Without a doubt, 2022 was a year of two halves full of highs and lows. We celebrated milestone achievements with Hannah Walleth (163 games) breaking the club record for most Women's games and Emma Zouch joining the 100 games club (101 games). We had Lauren Bird, Teagan Germech, Bonny McKean, Grace Read, Jorja Simpson, and Jaqueline Spence all represent GWS Giants during the year. And we had three players, Maddie Dwyer (CHB), Teagan (HBF) and Wally (CHF) recognised with for their individual performances with selection in the 2022 Team of the Year.

The women's program continued to grow in 2022 with some massive numbers joining the squad over preseason. At one stage we had almost 60 women show interest in joining the club, which included a mixture of returning players, transfers, players new to Canberra, and even players who had never played a competitive game. This number didn't even include our Rising Stars and helped ensure a solid preseason. During the preseason, we also participated in the inaugural Queanbeyan Cup which had teams from all over NSW and the ACT compete in a round-robin format. It was a great opportunity for our squad to get some solid competitive games under their belt before the season started. It was also a great example of the effort being put into Women's football in our region, and helps clubs provide their Women's teams with some quality trial games which normally are difficult to organise.

The 2022 season saw 14 players debut in First Grade demonstrating great depth in our squad, with 7 players under 18 years old highlighting an exciting future ahead.

The season got off to a great start, winning 5 of our first 6 games with the only loss by 1 point in the dying minutes of the game. During that period we averaged 9 goals a game whilst holding opposition teams to 3 goals or less. We were second on the ladder and really encouraged the "team first" mantra. Unfortunately, the second half of the season struggled to mirror our first half. Injury, illness or GWS Giants selection hampered the team's ability to sustain any continuity, with the team unable to select an unchanged side for back-to-back weeks. Absences to key positions forced some to play in roles that they're not comfortable with, but the players to their credit did their best. The lack of continuity clearly had an impact as we dropped from 9 goals a game to 5, which included going goalless in two games. Some solid wins to finish the home and away season definitely built the confidence heading into the finals, but scoring continued to be our Achilles heel. We weren't able to generate enough scoreboard pressure to give ourselves the best chance to succeed, and ended up being knocked out with back to back losses.

We were extremely fortunate to have Ernst & Young return as the major sponsor for the Women's program. EY's sponsorship has been a crucial enabler to the program and gave our entire squad a great platform to compete every week. Thank you to Jo Foster and Sheridan Lockerbie for their support this year as Assistant Coaches, and to Scott Reid as the Second Grade Coach. Everyone put in a huge number of hours outside of game day and I appreciate everything you did for the group this year.

First grade women's report

Thanks to Alex Thompson for stepping up as the Team Manager. It was so helpful knowing that you had everything ready to go for the team week in, week out. I also want to say thanks to Chloe Pellow, and all the Second Grade players who assisted as Runners. We could not have operated on gameday without your assistance, so thank you very much. Finally, thanks to the team at Elite Rehab & Sports, but most importantly, to Natasha Hart. Tash was amazing for us this year from post-match injury assessments, to developing rehab programs, and looking after the players every Saturday. Tash's professionalism and devotion to the players make her an irreplaceable member of the team.

We clearly demonstrated that we had the structure and talent to be successful this year, but lacked any consistency in the back half of the season. It's a disappointing way to finish 2022, and hopefully the group can get back to playing "team first" football so they can realise their full potential and turn the tables on the competition in 2023.

Second grade men's report

The 2's entered the 2022 season hungry and determined after Covid prevented us from attempting to go back-to-back after our 2020 success. From the core of our side last year, we had a number of guys progress into regular 1st grade starters and also said farewell to experienced leaders and valued members of the club Dan Posch and Chip Bradley. The holes left and the continued challenges from Covid/open borders provided exciting and regular opportunities for everyone in our squad, including 10 of our u18s.

Despite all the challenges and lack of continuity in our side week-to-week, the squad were able to come together, work hard and all be on the same page. We had a fantastic finish to the year, becoming the 2022 Premiers in a 30 odd point win over rivals Ainslie! Everything on the day went right, we were prepared, we'd built ourselves up for key moments, we improved each week and went into the finals full of belief and confidence. Our attack on the ball, our pressure and our composure were all 10 out of 10. It completely took Ainslie out of the game. To then roll through after half time, not letting them have a sniff, and be able to really enjoy each moment was great.

We spoke in the lead up about the equal importance of our leaders stepping up and our younger less experienced guys needing to step up too. To have all 22 guys contribute and win their moments was so pleasing. Our best team performance this year by a mile!

However, getting to that special point took a mountain of work from a lot of guys. We fielded a total of 60 players in the 2's this year.

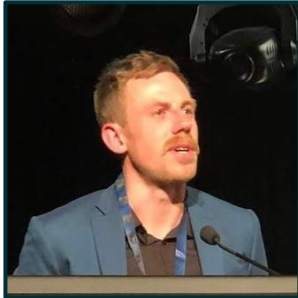

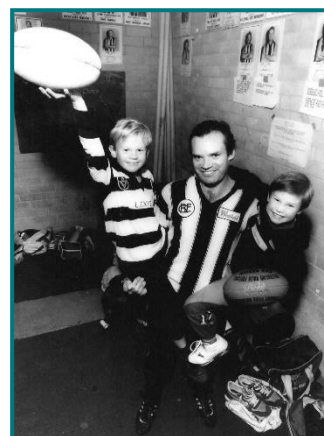
